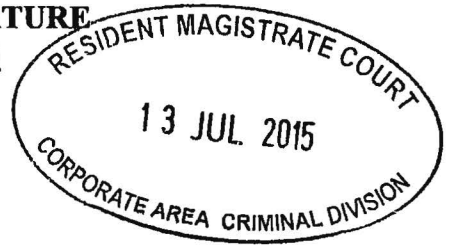



4. That the Applicant continues to be in custody without any charges being preferred against him.

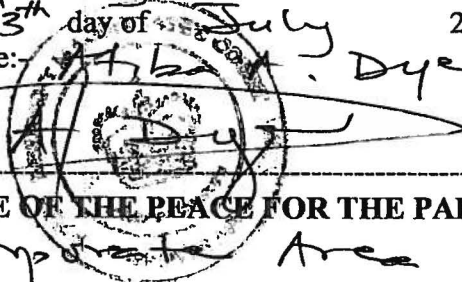
**WHEREFORE I HUMBLY PRAY** that this Honourable Court may be pleased to order the release of the Applicant forthwith.
