THE JUDICATURE (RULES OF COURT) ACT

THE CIVIL PROCEDURE (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2021

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Rules Committee of the Supreme Court by section 4 of the Judicature (Rules of Court) Act, the following Rules are made:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) Rules, 2021 and shall be read and construed as one with the Civil Procedure Rules, 2002, and all amendments thereto.

2. Rule 65.28 is amended by deleting paragraph (1) and substituting therefor the following—

“ (1) The appellant must file an appeal notice in form 29, within 14 days after the end of the taxation hearing.”.
