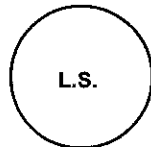

THE CONSTITUTION OF JAMAICA
A PROCLAMATION



PATRICK L. ALLEN,
Governor-General.

By His Excellency, the Most Honourable Sir
PATRICK LINTON ALLEN, Member of the Order
of the Nation, Knight Grand Cross of the Most
Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint
George, Commander of the Order of Distinction,
Knight of Grace of the Most Venerable Order
of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem,
Governor-General of Jamaica.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 63 of the Constitution of Jamaica that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place and shall commence at such time as the Governor-General may by Proclamation appoint:

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that a session of the Parliament of Jamaica should be held at such place and commence at such time as shall hereinafter appear:

NOW THEREFORE, I, PATRICK LINTON ALLEN, Member of the Order of the Nation, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Order of Distinction, Knight of Grace of the Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem, Governor-General of Jamaica, in exercise of the power conferred on me by subsection (1) of section 63 of the Constitution of Jamaica, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AND MAKE KNOWN that a session of the Parliament of Jamaica shall be held at the Jamaica Conference Centre in the parish of Kingston on the 15th day of September, 2020 commencing at 11:00 a.m. in respect of the Senate and the House of Representatives.

Given under my hand and the Broad Seal of Jamaica at King's House this 14th day of September in the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand and Twenty and the Sixty-ninth Year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
