**THE CUSTOMS ACT**

**THE CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2021**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 257 of the Customs Act, the following Regulations are made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 2021, and shall be read and construed as one with the Customs Regulations, 1955, (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”) and all amendments thereto.

2. Regulation 6B of the principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words “and (6)” and substituting therefor the words “, (6) and (7)”; and

---

(b) by inserting next after paragraph (6), the following—

“ (7) The customs processing fee imposed for exports under paragraph (1) shall not apply to goods for outright export not exceeding US\$ 500.00 in value, in respect of an export entry Form No. C82 for Shipping Bill for Export.

(8) In this regulation, “outright export” means the export of goods with the intention that those goods remain permanently outside Jamaica.”.
