Extract from the Minutes of the meeting of the House of Representatives held on Tuesday, July 19, 2022:

PUBLIC BUSINESS

The Honourable Nigel Clarke, MP, Minister of Finance and the Public Service, having obtained the suspension of the Standing Orders, moved:

THE CUSTOMS ACT

THE CUSTOMS TARIFF (REVISION) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) RESOLUTION, 2022

WHEREAS section 5(1) of the Customs Act provides that it shall be lawful for the House of Representatives, from time to time, by resolution, to impose import or export duties of customs upon any goods whatsoever which may be imported into or exported from the Island, and to revoke, reduce, increase or alter any such duties, and to provide for the importation or exportation of any goods without payment of any customs duties thereon:

AND WHEREAS the House of Representatives, with effect from the 1st day of January, 1973, by Resolution entitled the Customs Tariff (Revision) Resolution, 1972, imposed the import customs duties, set out in the First Schedule to the Resolution:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff (Revision) Resolution, in the manner hereinafter appearing:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives as follows:—

1. This Resolution may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Revision) (Amendment) (No. 2) Resolution, 2022, and shall be read and construed as one with the Customs Tariff (Revision) Resolution, 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Resolution”), and all amendments thereto.

2. With effect from the date of publication of this Resolution in the *Gazette*, and for a period of five years ending on the anniversary date of publication, the First Schedule to the principal Resolution is amended by deleting the items relating to Tariff Heading No. 8703.80 and substituting therefor the following—
