**THE EMERGENCY POWERS ACT**

**THE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS, 2019**

**DETENTION (OKEEM NOBLE) (STATE OF PUBLIC EMERGENCY FOR THE PARISHES  
OF ST. JAMES, HANOVER AND WESTMORELAND) ORDER, 2019**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by regulations 33 and 38 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2019, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Detention (Okeem Noble) (State of Public Emergency for the Parishes of St. James, Hanover and Westmoreland) Order, 2019.
2. Okeem Noble is to be detained from November 14, 2019 until the end of the period of the public emergency which commenced with the Proclamation of the Governor-General published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement Proclamation, Rules and Regulations on the 30th day of April, 2019.

3. For the purposes of paragraph 13 of regulation 38, notice is hereby given as follows:

- (a) Okeem Noble has been concerned in acts prejudicial to public safety and public order, more specifically:
  - i. Currently charged with five (5) counts each of Possession of Identity Information and Possession of Access Device contrary to the Law Reform (Fraudulent Transactions) (Special Provisions) Act. The matter is currently before the Hanover Parish Court holden at Lucea;
  - ii. Suspected of being involved in lottery scamming, extortion and shootings related to gang activities; and
  - iii. Suspected of being a member of a criminal organization, the "Hundred Rounds" gang and the "Cash in Hand Family".
- (b) Section 13(10) of the Constitution of Jamaica gives you the right to request a review of your case at any time during the period of your detention which is to be reviewed by The Emergency Powers Tribunal and Regulation 38(9) of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2019 gives you the right to make objection against the Detention Order to The Emergency Powers Review Tribunal.

4. In accordance with paragraph 14 of regulation 38, please be advised of the following:

- (a) The Notice of Objection Form may be accessed from the commanding officer at your place of detention or online at [mns.gov.jm](http://mns.gov.jm).
- (b) A completed Notice of Objection Form may be submitted to the Secretariat of the Emergency Powers Review Tribunal at The Wexford Hotel at 39 Gloucester Avenue, Montego Bay or via email to [eprtsecretariat@gmail.com](mailto:eprtsecretariat@gmail.com).
- (c) After the completed Notice of Objection Form has been submitted, you or your representative will be contacted and invited to a hearing where you may present your case to The Emergency Powers Review Tribunal.
