THE EMERGENCY POWERS ACT

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2020

DETENTION (RAYON THOMPSON O/C RYAN)
(STATE OF PUBLIC EMERGENCY FOR THE PARISH OF KINGSTON AND ST. ANDREW) ORDER, 2020

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by regulations 33(1) and 38 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2020, the following Order is hereby made:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Detention (Rayon Thompson o/c Ryan) (State of Public Emergency for the parish of Kingston and St. Andrew) Order, 2020.
- 2. Rayon Thompson o/c Ryan, is to be detained from June 30, 2020 until the end of the period of the public emergency which commenced with the Proclamation of the Governor-General published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement Proclamations, Rules and Regulations on the 26th day of January, 2020.

- 3. For the purposes of paragraph 11 of regulation 38, notice is hereby given as follows:
 - (a) Rayon Thompson o/c Ryan, has been concerned in acts prejudicial to public safety and public order, more specifically that he is suspected of the following:
 - (i) Suspected of being the leader of a criminal organization the Back Bush Gang o/c the System — operating in the Back Bush community located in the Mountain View area of the Kingston Eastern Division.
 - (ii) Suspected of being in possession of illegal firearms in the Back Bush community and of supplying illegal firearms to members of the Back Bush Gang.
 - (iii) Suspected of giving instructions to members of the Back Bush Gang to carry out beatings of persons in the Back Bush community.
 - (b) Section 13(10) of the Constitution of Jamaica gives you the right to request a review of your case at any time during the period of your detention which is to be reviewed by The Emergency Powers Tribunal and Regulation 38(6) of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2019, gives you the right to make objection against the Detention Order to The Emergency Powers Review Tribunal.
- 4. In accordance with paragraph 12 of regulation 38, please be advised of the following:
 - (a) The Notice of Objection Form may be accessed from the commanding officer at your place of detention or online at mns.gov.jm.
 - (b) A completed Notice of Objection Form may be submitted to the Secretariat of the Emergency Powers Review Tribunal at the Ministry of National Security, Fourth (4th) Floor, NCB Towers, North Tower, 2 Oxford Road, Kingston 5, St. Andrew or via email to eastkingstonERT@gmail.com.
 - (c) After the completed Notice of Objection Form has been submitted, you or your representative will be contacted and invited to a hearing where you may present your case to The Emergency Powers Review Tribunal.
