THE EMERGENCY POWERS ACT

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2019

DETENTION (TIVANI TAYLOR O/C GUNS) (STATE OF
PUBLIC EMERGENCY FOR THE PARISHES OF ST. JAMES, HANOVER AND
WESTMORELAND ORDER, 2019

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by regulations 33 (1) and 38 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2019, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Detention (Tivani Taylor o/c Guns) (State of Public Emergency for the parishes of St. James, Hanover and Westmoreland) Order, 2019.
2. Tivani Taylor o/c Guns, is to be detained from May 4, 2020 until the end of the period of the public emergency which commenced with the Proclamation of the Governor-General published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement Proclamation, Rules and Regulations on the 7th day of May, 2019.

3. For the purposes of paragraph 11 of regulation 38, notice is hereby given as follows:

- (a) Tivani Taylor o/c Guns, is suspected to be concerned in acts prejudicial to public safety and public order, more specifically:
 - (i) Suspected of being involved in the murder of Orian Reid and the wounding with intent of Delroy Kennedy and Derron Marston committed on November 4, 2019 at 110 Lane, Savanna-la-Mar, Westmoreland.
 - (ii) Currently charged for the murder of Kashwayne Bennett o/c Lasso committed on March 23, 2020 in the Roaring River community, Petersfield, Westmoreland.
 - (iii) Suspected of being a member of a criminal organization namely the Dalling Street Gang operating in the Dalling Street community of Savanna-la-Mar, Westmoreland and being involved in gang related shootings. The gang activities include lottery scamming, extortion of lottery scammers and contract killings.
- (b) Section 13(10) of the Constitution of Jamaica gives you the right to request a review of your case at any time during the period of your detention which is to be reviewed by The Emergency Powers Tribunal and Regulation 38(6) of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2019 gives you the right to make objection against the Detention Order to The Emergency Powers Review Tribunal.

4. In accordance with paragraph 12 of regulation 38, please be advised of the following:

- (a) The Notice of Objection Form may be accessed from the commanding officer at your place of detention or online at mns.gov.jm.
- (b) A completed Notice of Objection Form may be submitted to the Secretariat of the Emergency Powers Review Tribunal at The Wexford Hotel at 39 Gloucester Avenue, Montego Bay or via email to westerntrib@2019@gmail.com.
- (c) After the completed Notice of Objection Form has been submitted, you or your representative will be contacted and invited to a hearing where you may present your case to The Emergency Powers Review Tribunal.
