**THE DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT ACT**

THE DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT (ENFORCEMENT  
MEASURES) (NO. 11) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2021

WHEREAS the Minister responsible for disaster preparedness and emergency management has given written notice to the Prime Minister that Jamaica appears to be threatened with or affected by the SARS-CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19), and that measures apart from or in addition to those specifically provided for in the Disaster Risk Management Act should be taken promptly:

AND WHEREAS on March 13, 2020, the Prime Minister by Order declared the whole of Jamaica to be a disaster area:

NOW THEREFORE:

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Prime Minister by section 26(2) of the Disaster Risk Management Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Disaster Risk Management (Enforcement Measures) (No. 11) (Amendment) Order, 2021, and shall be read and construed as one with the Disaster

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Risk Management (Enforcement Measures) (No. 11) Order, 2021 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

(2) This Order shall take effect on the 18th day of November, 2021.

2. Paragraph 4 of the principal Order is amended by—

(a) deleting sub-paragraph (4) and substituting therefor the following—

“ (4) In any case where—

(a) the person has—

- (i) provided in accordance with sub-paragraph (1) a negative COVID-19 test other than a RT-PCR test; and
- (ii) been fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19) and not less than fourteen days have elapsed since the person received the dose of the vaccination required for the person to be medically considered as fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19),

the period of the quarantine under sub-paragraph (2)(c) shall be eight days; or

(b) the person has—

- (i) provided in accordance with sub-paragraph (1) a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test; and
- (ii) been fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19) and not less than fourteen days have elapsed since the person received the dose of the vaccination required for the person to be medically considered as fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19),

sub-paragraph (2)(c) shall not apply.”

3. Paragraph 5 of the principal Order is amended—

(a) in sub-paragraph (3) by deleting the words “sub-paragraph (6)” and substituting therefor the words “sub-paragraphs (6) and (8)”; and

(b) inserting next after sub-paragraph (7) the following sub-paragraphs—

“ (8) Notwithstanding sub-paragraph (3)(a), the person may leave the person’s abode or place of residence referred to in that sub-paragraph and may leave the Resilient Corridor described in the Second Schedule, if—

- (a) the person has been fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19);

- (b) not less than fourteen days have elapsed since the person received the dose of the vaccination required for the person to be medically considered as fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19); and
  - (c) the person tests negative for the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19) on a RT-PCT test taken, at the person’s expense, on the person’s arrival in Jamaica.
- (9) Sub-paragraphs (3)(a), (4)(c), (6) and (7) shall not apply to a person described in sub-paragraph (1) if—
- (a) the test provided by the person in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) is a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test;
  - (b) the person has been fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19); and
  - (c) not less than fourteen days have elapsed since the person received the dose of the vaccination required for the person to be medically considered as fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19).”.

4. Paragraph 6 of the principal Order is amended—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (1) by deleting the words “A person” and substituting therefor the words “Subject to sub-paragraph (5), a person”; and
- (b) inserting next after sub-paragraph (4) the following sub-paragraph—
  - “ (5) A person shall not be required to remain in quarantine under sub-paragraph (1) if—
  - (a) the test provided by the person in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) is a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test;
  - (b) the person has been fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19); and
  - (c) not less than fourteen days have elapsed since the person received the dose of the vaccination required for the person to be medically considered as fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19).”.

5. Paragraph 7 of the principal Order is amended—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (3) by deleting the words “A person” and substituting therefor the words “Subject to sub-paragraph (5), a person”; and
- (b) by deleting sub-paragraph (5) and substituting therefor the following—
  - “ (5) In any case where—
  - (a) the person has—
    - (i) provided in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) a negative COVID-19 test, other than a RT-PCR test; and

- (ii) been fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19), and not less than fourteen days have elapsed since the person received the dose of the vaccination required for the person to be medically considered as fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19),

the period of the quarantine under sub-paragraph (3)(b) shall be eight days; or

- (b) the person has—
  - (i) provided in accordance with sub-paragraph (2) a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test; and
  - (ii) been fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19), and not less than fourteen days have elapsed since the person received the dose of the vaccination required for the person to be medically considered as fully vaccinated against the SARS – CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19),

sub-paragraph (3)(b) shall not apply.”.

6. Paragraph 10(1) of the principal Order is amended by deleting the words “October 29, 2021, to December 10, 2021, during the hours from 8:00 pm each day to 5:00 am the following day, beginning at 8:00 pm on October 29, 2021” and substituting therefor the words “November 18, 2021, to December 10, 2021, during the hours from 9:00 pm each day to 5:00 am the following day, beginning at 9:00 pm on November 18, 2021”.

7. Paragraph 18(2) of the principal Order is amended—

- (a) by deleting the words “October 29” and substituting therefor the words “November 18”; and
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) by deleting the numerals “15” and “10” and substituting therefor, respectively, the numerals “20” and “15”.

8. Paragraph 19(1) is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (a) and substituting therefor the following—

- “ (a) during the period from November 18, 2021, to December 9, 2021, no more than 100 persons shall be physically present at any time at the place of worship;”.

9. Paragraph 20 of the principal Order is amended—

- (a) by deleting the words “October 29” and substituting therefor the words “November 18”; and
- (b) in sub-paragraph (a) by deleting the numerals “50” and substituting therefor the numerals “100”.

10. The principal Order is amended by deleting paragraph 23 and substituting therefor the following—

“Annual general meeting of company or society.

23. During the period from November 18, 2021, to December 9, 2021, notwithstanding anything set out in the Fourth Schedule gatherings for the purpose of any annual general meeting or extraordinary general meeting of—

- (a) a company under the Companies Act; or
- (b) a society registered under the Co-operative Societies Act, the Friendly Societies Act or the Industrial and Provident Societies Act,

shall not exceed 100 persons in physical attendance at any time.”.
