**THE DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT ACT**

THE DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT (ENFORCEMENT MEASURES)  
(NO. 4) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2020

WHEREAS the Minister responsible for disaster preparedness and emergency management has given written notice to the Prime Minister that Jamaica appears to be threatened with or affected by the SARS - CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19), and that measures apart from or in addition to those specifically provided for in the Disaster Risk Management Act should be taken promptly:

AND WHEREAS on the 13th day of March, 2020, the Prime Minister by Order declared the whole of Jamaica to be a disaster area:

---

38B. Duties as a person employed, or contracted, to catch, land or process fish pursuant to a licence or permit issued under the Fisheries Act.”.
