THE EMERGENCY POWERS ACT

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (No. 2) REGULATIONS, 2018

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (SPECIFIED AREAS IN THE PARISH OF ST. CATHERINE)
(OPENING HOURS OF ESTABLISHMENTS) ORDER, 2018

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister of National Security by regulation 37 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2018 (the Minister being an authorized person as defined by regulation 2(1) of those Regulations), the following Order is hereby made:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Specified Areas in the Parish of St. Catherine) (Opening Hours of Establishments) Order, 2018.
- 2. In the community in the parish of St. Catherine in which the state of public emergency exists, as set out in the Schedule of the Proclamation declaring a state of emergency, made by the Governor-General on the 18th day of March, 2018, the following

establishments shall be closed and remain closed except during the hours, and for the purposes, specified as follows—

	Description of Establishment	Opening Hours —	Purpose
1.	Clubs and fast food restaurants	From 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m.	The normal operations of the establishment.
2.	Every place required by law to operate under a tavern licence	From 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.	The normal operations of the establishment.
3.	Petroleum filling stations	From 6:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m.	The normal operations of the establishment.
4.	Supermarkets, grocery shops, haberdasheries and any other place (other than a place referred to in any other paragraph of this table) offering goods for sale	From 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.	The normal operations of the establishment.
5.	Pharmacies	From 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.	The normal operations of the establishment.
6.	Any other public place	From 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.	The normal operations of the establishment.
