**THE EMERGENCY POWERS ACT**

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2018

THE EMERGENCY POWERS VARIATION OF DETENTION ORDER OF  
(ANDRAE WHITTAKER) (STATE OF PUBLIC EMERGENCY FOR THE PARISH OF  
ST. JAMES) ORDER, 2019

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by regulations 33(3) of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2018, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers Variation of Detention Order of (Andrae Whittaker) (State of Public Emergency for the parish of St. James) Order, 2019.
2. Andrae Whittaker by Detention Order dated July 3, 2018 was to be detained from July 3, 2018 until the end of the period of the public emergency which commenced with the Proclamation of the Governor-General published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement Proclamation, Rules and Regulations on the 18th day of January, 2018.

3. In light of circumstances, the above-mentioned Detention Order, by this Order, has been varied. In accordance with paragraph 9 of Regulation 38, please be advised of the following:

- (a) Mr. Whittaker shall be released from the Montego Bay lock up and permitted to remain in the confines of the agreed address between the hours of 7:00 pm and 6:00 am until the State of Emergency ends. For the purposes of this Order, the agreed address is the address as represented by Mr. Whittaker's Attorney-at-Law;
- (b) Mr. Whittaker shall report to the Red Hills Police Station twice weekly, every week between the hours of 8:00 am and 5: 00 pm until the end of the State of Emergency;
- (c) Mr. Whittaker is not to be engaged in or associated with any criminal activity or suspected of being involved in any such activity; and
- (d) Mr. Whittaker is not permitted to enter the parish of St. James until the end of the State of Emergency without the prior written approval of the Commanding Officer in charge in St. James.

4. In accordance with Regulation 33(4), failure to comply with any of the conditions of this Order will result in the commission of an offence.
