THE HOUSING ACT

(Act 55 of 1968)

THE HOUSING SCHEME PART OF MINARD, SAINT ANN (HOUSING AREA) ORDER, 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister of section 4(1) of the Housing Act and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Scheme, part of Minard, Saint Ann (Housing Area) Order, 2018.
2. By this Order the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared a Housing Area.

SCHEDULE

All that parcel of land part of Minard situated in the parish of Saint Ann, being part of the lands registered at Volume 652 Folio 51 in the Registered Book of Titles, containing by survey 77.8173 Hectares (192.29 Acres) of land, be the same more or less.

The property is butted and bounded:

- NORTHERLY: on the Parochial Road leading from Orange Valley to Home Castle, and on the lands in the possession of Dunstan Williams, Devon Williams, Webster Lawrence, Herbert Dawson, Fugon Perry, Rupert Gordon and Sicily Mathews all of Cross Roads, Keith Post Office in the parish of Saint Ann;
- WESTERLY: on the Parochial Road leading from Home Castle to Retirement, lands registered at Volume 1392 Folio 186 in the name of Michael A. Gardener, lands registered at Volume 1374 Folio 35 in the name of Alanzo Maxwell and lands in the possession of Jasper Dawson, Jephthah Clayton, Raymond Ricketts, Phillip Williams and Glenford Delgado all of Lawrence Park, Browns Town Post Office in the parish of Saint Ann;
- SOUTHERLY: on the remainder of Minard registered at Volume 652 Folio 54;
- EASTERLY: on the said remainder of Minard registered at Volume 652 Folio 51, and more particular as delineated on the Boundary Plan of part of Minard prepared by Leslie B. Mae, Commissioned Land Surveyor, bearing National Land Agency—Survey and Mapping Division Examination No. PE: 405328 or howsoever else the same may be butted, bounded or described.
