**THE INTERCEPTION OF COMMUNICATIONS (AMENDMENT TO FIRST SCHEDULE)

WHEREAS under section 18(1) of the Interception of Communications Act the Minister may, by order, add to or delete from the list of offences contained in the First Schedule:

AND WHEREAS under section 18(1) of the Act the Minister made the Interception of Communications (Amendment to First Schedule) Order, 2019:

AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 18(2) of the Act that an order made under section 18(1) shall be subject to affirmative resolution:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the Interception of Communications (Amendment to First Schedule) Order, 2019, be affirmed:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Honourable House as follows:—

1. This Resolution may be cited as the Interception of Communications (Amendment to First Schedule) Order, 2019, Resolution.
2. The Interception of Communications (Amendment to First Schedule) Order, 2019, is affirmed.

THE INTERCEPTION OF COMMUNICATIONS ACT

THE INTERCEPTION OF COMMUNICATIONS (AMENDMENT TO FIRST SCHEDULE) ORDER, 2019

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 18 (1) of the Interception of Communications Act, and of every other power hereto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Interception of Communications (Amendment to First Schedule) Order, 2019, and shall be read and construed as one with the Interception of Communications Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), and all amendments thereto.
2. The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended by—
 - (a) renumbering paragraph 16 as paragraph 18 and inserting the following as paragraphs 16 and 17—

“16. An offence under Part II of the Criminal Justice (Suppression of Criminal Organizations) Act

“17. An offence under the Law Reform (Fraudulent Transactions) (Special Provisions) Act.”

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- (b) in paragraph 18 (as renumbered), by deleting the words "mentioned in paragraphs 1 to 15" and substituting therefor the words "specified in this Schedule."
