THE JAMAICA AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY ACT

THE JAMAICA AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY REGULATIONS, 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Jamaica Agricultural Commodities Regulatory Authority by section 37 of the Jamaica Agricultural Commodities Regulatory Authority Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following regulations are made, with the approval of the Minister:—

PART I.—Preliminary

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Jamaica Agricultural Commodities Regulatory Authority Regulations, 2018.

Interpretation.

First Schedule.

- 2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—
 - "Blue Mountain area of Jamaica" means the area specified in the First Schedule;
 - "export" means, in relation to a regulated agricultural commodity, to take, or cause the regulated agricultural commodity, to be taken out of Jamaica;
 - "import" means, in relation to a regulated agricultural commodity, to take, or cause the regulated agricultural commodity, to be taken into Jamaica;
 - "Jamaica Blue Mountain Blend Coffee" means any coffee or coffee product, comprising Jamaica Blue Mountain coffee in such proportion as to account for not less than thirty per cent of its weight;
 - "Jamaica Blue Mountain Coffee" means coffee that is grown in the Blue Mountain area of Jamaica;
 - "Jamaica High Mountain Supreme Blend Coffee" means a blend of coffee which contains not less than thirty *per cent* Jamaica High Mountain Supreme Coffee by weight;
 - "Jamaica High Mountain Supreme Coffee" means the premium grades from Jamaican coffee grown outside of the Blue Mountain area of Jamaica;
 - "registered property" means any property, the particulars of which, are entered in the Register of Registered Growers and Registered Properties, pursuant to regulation 9;
 - "regulated agricultural commodity business" means any business which is operated pursuant to section 14 of the Act;

"spice" means-

- (a) ginger;
- (b) nutmeg;
- (c) pimento (including the wood and leaves of the pimento tree);
- (d) turmeric; and
- (e) any product made from the commodities listed in paragraphs (a), (b), (c) or (d);

"works" means any-

- (a) plant;
- machinery; (b)
- (c) appliance;
- (d) mill;
- premises; or (e)
- apparatus, whether similar to those set out in paragraphs (a) to (d), or used for fermenting, curing, drying, cleaning, processing or preparing for sale, any regulated agricultural commodity.

PART II. Licences

Licence application. Forms 1A, IB, IC, ID and IE. Second Schedule.

Third Schedule.

Fee for grant of licence, etc. Third Schedule.

Exception.

- 3. An application for a licence pursuant to section 15(1), or the renewal of a licence pursuant to section 19(1) (a), of the Act, shall be in the form set out as Form 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D or 1E, as appropriate, in the Second Schedule and shall be accompanied by the application fee, specified in relation to the application, in the Third Schedule.
- 4. A person to whom a licence is granted under section 17 of the Act, shall pay the requisite fee specified in the Third Schedule.
- 5. Nothwithstanding section 14 of the Act, a regulated agricultural commodity may be imported into or exported from Jamaica otherwise than under a licence granted under section 17 of the Act
 - in a quantity not exceeding 5 kilograms when carried in the personal baggage of a passenger; or
 - in a quantity not exceeding 5 kilograms when sent by post, by sea (b) or by air as gift parcels or bona fide samples.

PART III.—Inspectors

Form of report. Forms 2A and 2B. Second Schedule.

6. The report required to be submitted by an inspector under section 17(2) of the Act shall be in the form set out as Form 2A or 2B, as is appropriate, in the Second Schedule.

Identification card for inspector. Form 3.

7. The indentification card required to be issued by the Authority to each inspector, pursuant to section 26(3) of the Act, shall be in the form set out as Form 3 in the Second Schedule.

PART IV.—Certificate of Registration and Regulated Agricultural Commodities, Generally

Application for certificate of registration. Form 4. Second Schedule.

- 8.—(1) An application for a certificate of registration pursuant to section 15(3) of the Act, shall be in the form set out as Form 4 in the Second Schedule.
- (2) The Authority may, upon receipt of an application under paragraph (1), request that the applicant furnish such additional information and documents as the Authority may consider relevant.
- (3) Sections 17, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26, 27 and 35 of the Act apply, mutatis mutandis, to a regulated agricultural commodity that is grown or intended to be grown in a quantity that is of commercial significance.

Form of certificate of registration. Form 5. Second Schedule.

- 9.—(1) A certificate of registration shall—
 - (a) be in the form set out as Form 5 in the Second Schedule; and
 - (b) bear a unique identification, consisting of alphanumeric characters.
- (2) Upon the grant of a certificate of registration, the Authority shall enter in the Register of Registered Growers and Registered Properties, kept pursuant to regulation 10, the particulars of the property on which the regulated agricultural commodity is grown.

Register of Registered Growers and Registered Properties.

- 10.—(1) The Authority shall keep and maintain a register to be called the Register of Registered Growers and Registered Properties.
- (2) The Register of Registered Growers and Registered Properties shall be—
 - (a) updated annually; and

(b) in the form set out as Form 6 in the Second Schedule.

Records and returns to be kept by holder of certificate of registration.

- 11.—(1) The holder of a certificate of registration shall keep such records, make sure returns and furnish such information as the Authority may, at any time, require in relation to all or any of the following matters—
 - (a) the acreage of regulated agricultural commodities grown by the holder of the certificate of registration;
 - the quantity of any regulated agricultural commodity available or likely to be available to be reaped by the holder of the certificate of registration;
 - (c) the manner in which, and the persons to whom, any regulated agricultural commodity grown is disposed of by the holder of the certificate of registration;

- (d) the name, location, and description of any property upon which the holder of the certificate of registration has grown or contemplates growing a regulated agricultural commodity; and
- (e) any other matter specified by the Authority.
- (2) Any records required to be kept by the holder of the certificate of registration under paragraph (1) shall be open to inspection at reasonable times by the authority upon presentation of a written request by the Authority.

Cancellation of certificate of registration.

- 12.—(1) The Authority may cancel a certificate of registration where the holder of the certificate ceases to grow the regulated agricultural commodity (which is the subject of the grant of the certificate) in a quantity of commercial significance.
- (2) Where a certificate of registration is cancelled, the particulars in relation to the property on which the regulated agricultural commodity is grown shall be removed from the Register of Registered Growers and Registered Properties by the Authority.

Change in status of regulated agricultural commodity and property.

- 13.—(1) For the purposes of this regulation "change in status" means a change in—
 - (a) the address, telephone number and electronic mail address of the holder of the certificate of registration;
 - (b) the ownership of the property on which the regulated agricultural commodity is grown;
 - (c) the acreage of the property on which the regulated agricultural commodity is grown;
 - (d) Where applicable, the terms of the lease in relation to the property on which the regulated agricultural commodity is grown;
 - the type, acreage and quantity of the regulated agricultural commodity grown on the registered property; and
 - (f) any other aspect of a change in status as may be specified by notice by the Authority.
- (2) Every holder of a certificate of registration shall give to the Authority written notice, specifying any change in status, at least within one month of such change.
- (3) Where there is a change in status pursuant to paragraph (1) (b), the holder of the certificate of registration who has ceased to be the owner of the property on which a regulated agricultural commodity is grown, shall make a

Form 7. Second Schedule. return to the Authority in the form set as Form 7 in the Second Schedule, specifying—

- (a) the date upon which he ceased to be the owner of the property;
- (b) the circumstances under which he ceased to be the owner of the property;
- (c) the quantity of regulated agricultural commodity reaped by the owner from the property in the crop year immediately preceding the day he ceased to be the owner of the property;
- (d) the manner in which, the purposes for which and the persons to whom he disposed any regulated agricultural commodity;
- (e) the name and address of any person who (consequent upon the acquisition of that property and the intention of that person to grow on the property, a regulated agricultural commodity in a quantity of commercial significance) is required to apply to the Authority for a certificate of registration under section 15(3) of the Act; and
- (f) any other information that the Authority may require.
- (4) Where the person to whom property has been transferred intends to grown any regulated agricultural commodity, in a quantity of commercial significance, that person shall apply for a certificate of registration under section 15(3) of the Act.
- (5) Where an arrangement has been made between the previous owner of property on which a regulated agricultural commodity is grown and the person to whom the property has been transferred, for the previous owner to continue to grow, on the same property, a regulated agricultural commodity, in a quantity of commercial significance, the previous owner of the property shall retain his certificate of registration, and is not required to apply for a new certificate of registration under section 15(3) of the Act.

Transactions with dealers.

- 14. Every holder of a certificate of registration in relation to a regulated agricultural commodity who delivers the regulated agricultural commodity to any dealer or his agent shall—
 - (a) produce to that dealer or his agent, his certificate of registration;
 - (b) deliver to the dealer or his agent, a written receipt, signed by the holder of the certificate of registration, specifying—
 - (i) the name of the holder of the certificate of registration;
 - (ii) the quantity of the regulated agricultural commodity delivered;

- (iii) the name, if any, and address of the property upon which the regulated agricultural commodity was grown; and
- (iv) any other particulars required by the Authority.

Records to be kept by dealers.

- 15.—(1) Every dealer shall keep a record of any regulated agricultural commodity that he buys or sells, specifying—
 - (a) the quantity of the regulated agricultural commodity;
 - (b) the name and address of the holder of a certificate of registration from whom the regulated agricultural commodity was brought or to whom the regulated agricultural commodity was sold;
 - the name, if any, of the property or properties on which the regulated agricultural commodity was grown;
 - (d) the registration number of the certificate of registration;
 - (e) the date the regulated agricultural commodity was brought or sold;
 - (f) the amount paid over or received in relation to the regulated agricultural commodity brought or sold;
 - (g) where applicable, the grade, type and quality of the regulated agricultural commodity; and
 - (h) any other particulars required by the Authority.
- (2) All records kept under paragraph (1) shall be kept by the dealer for a period of at least seven years after the last entry of particulars was entered in the record book.

Registers of licenced regulated agricultural commodities.

- 16.—(1) The Authority shall keep, in a manner determined by the Authority, separate registers in relation to each regulated agricultural commodity.
- (2) The registers referred to in paragraph (1) shall contain the following particulars—
 - (a) the name and address of each licence holder;
 - the name, if any, description and address of the property on which the licence holder carries on his regulated agricultural commodity business;
 - (c) the date on which the Authority granted each licence;
 - (d) where applicable, the date on which the Authority revoked the licence; and
 - (e) any other matter required to be recorded by the Authority.

PART V.—Sale or Relocation of Regulated Agricultural Commodity Business

Sale or relocation of regulated agricultural commodity business.

- 17.—(1) Where the holder of a licence sells the whole or any part of his interest in a regulated agricultural commodity business, he shall, within fourteen days of the completion of sale, inform the Authority in writing of the sale.
- (2) If the holder of a licence of a regulated agricultural commodity relocates his regulated agricultural commodity business he shall, within fourteen days of the relocation of the business, inform the Authority in writing of the relocation.
- (3) Every sale or relocation of a regulated agricultural commodity business shall be noted in the relevant register referred to in regulation 16.

PART VI.--Coffee

Coffee berries and coffee beans; restrictions.

- 18.—(1) A person shall not, for commercial purposes, pick, collect, offer for sale, sell or buy—
 - (a) coffee containing berries that are entirely green in colour;
 - (b) black coffee berries, containing stones, trash or other foreign matter;
 - (c) coffee, dried in the whole shell or double husk; or
 - (d) coffee that has not been dried in accordance with the required standards of the Authority.
- (2) A person who contravenes paragraph (1), commits an offence and is liable, on summary conviction in a Parish Court—
 - (a) in the case of an individual—
 - to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months;
 - (ii) for a second conviction, to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months;
 - (iii) for an offence committed subsequent to a conviction for a second offence, to a fine not exceeding three million dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve months;

(b) in the case of a body corporate, to a fine not exceeding five million dollars.

Restrictions on the local sale and export of roasted coffee.

- 19.—(1) Notwithstanding regulation 18, a person shall not offer for sale in Jamaica, or export, roasted coffee made from imported green coffee beans, unless the roasted coffee is a blend comprising coffee cultivated and produced in Jamaica in such proportion as to account for not less than 30 per cent of the weight of the roasted coffee offered for sale or exported.
- (2) A person who contravenes paragraph (1) commits an offence and shall be liable, on summary conviction in a Parish Court, to a fine not exceeding two million dollars and in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve months.

Conditions for coffee dealer licence.

- 20. The Authority shall attach the following conditions to a licence granted to a coffee dealer and a special coffee dealer—
 - (a) the coffee dealer and special coffee dealer shall produce a business plan indicating his present and planned level of investment in the registered coffee property and the proposed level of coffee yield; and
 - (b) the coffee dealer shall agree in writing to grow the amount of coffee as the Authority shall stipulate, from time to time, having regard to climate and environmental conditions and the economic conditions existing in Jamaica.

Export of coffee and coffee products.

- 21.—(1) A person shall not, unless authorized in writing by the Authority—
 - (a) purchase, sell or export coffee or a coffee product, other than Jamaica Blue Mountain Coffee, Jamaica Blue Mountain Blend Coffee, Jamaica High Mountain Supreme Blend Coffee, or Jamaica High Mountain Supreme Coffee, under a name that contains the words "Blue Mountain" or "High Mountain"; or
 - (b) carry out any activity that is connected with the purchase, sale or export of coffee or a coffee product which involves the use of the words "Blue Mountain" or "High Mountain".
- (2) A person who contravenes paragraph (1) commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction in a Parish Court to a fine not exceeding two million dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve months.

Custody and ownership of coffee for export.

22.—(1) Green coffee beans that have been approved by the Authority for export shall remain in the physical custody of the Authority but the dealer who is authorized, in writing, by the Authority to export the coffee from Jamaica shall retain ownership of the coffee.

- (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), the Authority shall export green coffee beans on behalf of the dealer.
- (3) Any loss or damage to coffee that is in the physical custody of the Authority under paragraph (1), shall be the responsibility of the Authority, unless it can be shown that responsibility for that loss or damage lies with a person or entity other than the Authority.

Record to be kept by coffee works operator.

- 23.—(1) Every operator of a coffee works to whom a licence has been granted shall keep a record of the source of supply of the coffee or the ingredients of the blend, as the case may be, where the operator of the coffee works, processes or manufactures—
 - (a) Jamaica Blue Mountain Coffee;
 - (b) Jamaica Blue Mountain Blend Coffee;
 - (c) Jamaica High Mountain Supreme Blend Coffee; or
 - (d) Jamaica High Mountain Supreme Coffee.
- (2) A person who contravenes paragraph (1) commits an offence and is liable, on summary conviction in a Parish Court—
 - (a) in the case of an individual—
 - to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment of a term not exceeding three months;
 - for a second conviction, to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months;
 - (iii) for an offence committed subsequent to a conviction for a second offence, to a fine not exceeding three million dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve months;
 - in the case of a body corporate, to a fine not exceeding five million dollars.

PART VII.--Cocoa

Restriction on sale of cocoa for processing.

- 24.—(1) A cocoa dealer shall not sell cocoa for processing, which contains—
 - (a) placenta;
 - (b) stones;

- (c) trash;
- (d) any other foreign matter other than those mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (c), inclusive; or
- (e) beans that-
 - (i) are germinating or have germinated; or
 - (ii) are from pods infected with black pod or immature.
- (2) A dealer shall not sell cocoa which has not been fermented or dried in accordance with the standards established by the Authority.
- (3) A person who contravenes paragraph (1) or (2) commits an offence and is liable, on summary conviction in a Parish Court—
 - (a) in the case of an individual—
 - to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months;
 - (ii) for a second conviction, to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months;
 - (iii) for an offence committed subsequent to a conviction for a second offence, to a fine not exceeding three million dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve months;
 - (b) in the case of a body corporate, to a fine not exceeding five million dollars.

Conditions of cocoa dealer licence.

25. The Authority shall attach, as conditions to a licence granted to a cocoa dealer dealer the following—

- (a) that the cocoa dealer produces a business plan indicating his present and planned—
 - level of investment in the registered cocoa property;
 and
 - (ii) level of cocoa output; and

- (b) the cocoa dealer shall agree in writing to grow such amount of cocoa as the Authority shall stipulate from time to time, having regard to—
 - (i) climate and environmental conditions; and
 - (ii) economic conditions existing in Jamaica from time to time.

Cocoa for export.

- 26.—(1) All cocoa for export shall be approved by the Authority prior to the shipment of the cocoa.
- (2) The Authority shall keep in storage, representative samples of all shipment of cocoa.

PART VIII. -Pimento

Pimento for export.

- 27.—(1) All pimento for export shall be approved by the Authority prior to the shipment of the pimento.
- (2) The Authority shall keep in storage, representative samples of all shipment of pimento.

PART IX.—Processing and Storage of Regulated Agricultural Commodities

Restriction on sale of regulated agricultural commodities produced, etc. at processing facility.

- 28.—(1) A person shall not sell or offer for sale to any person, any regulated agricultural commodity or its substitute, which conveys, or is likely to convey the impression that the regulated agricultural commodity or is substitute was produced, processed or manufactured at any processing facility, unless it is in fact produced, processed or manufactured at that processing facility.
- (2) A person who contravenes paragraph (1) commits an offence and is liable, on summary conviction in a Parish Court, to a fine not exceeding two million dollars and, in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve months.

Processing and storage of regulated agricultural commodity on approved land or premises. 29. Where a regulated agricultural commodity is being prepared for export or local distribution, a person shall not process or store the regulated agricultural commodity on any land or premises, unless the land or premises has first been approved by the Authority as suitable for the processing or storing of the regulated agricultural commodity.

Inspection of premises to be used for the processing and storage of a regulated agricultural commodity.

30. The Authority—

- may make periodic inspections of all land or premises approved as suitable for the processing and storage of a regulated agricultural commodity;
- (b) shall make an inspection where it is suspected that any land or premises may be unsuitable for the processing and storage of a regulated agricultural commodity; and
- (c) shall cause such inspections to be carried out, where a complaint has been made regarding the quality of a regulated agricultural commodity.

Register of premises to be used for the processing and storage of a regulated agricultural commodity. 31. The Authority shall keep a register of all land or premises approved as suitable for the processing and storage of a regulated agricultural commodity, setting out the following—

- (a) the name of every person owning, leasing or in possession of the land or premises;
- (b) the name, if any, address and description of the land or premises;
- (c) the date on which the land or premises were approved;
- (d) the date of any revocation of approval of the land or premises as suitable for the processing and storage of a regulated agricultural commodity.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Blue Mountain Area of Jamaica

Starting at Skibo and proceeding in an east-south-easterly direction to Swift River; thence east-south-easterly to Chelsea; thence east-southeasterly to Durham (Samba Hill); thence south-easterly to Belleview; thence southeasterly along the western slope of the John Crow Mountain to Cedar Grove; thence westerly to Font Hill; thence north-westerly to Ramble; thence westerly to Good Hope; thence northwesterly to Dallas; thence north-north-westerly to Industry Village; thence north and north-westerly to Maryland; thence northwesterly to Golden Spring; thence northerly to Brandon Hill; thence northeasterly to Tranquility; thence east-north-easterly to Skibo.
