THE JUDICIARY ACT

THE JUDICIARY (SALARIES) ORDER, 2021

In exercise of the power conferred on the Minister by section 4(2) of the Judiciary Act, the following Order is hereby made by the Minister after taking into account the recommendations of the ninth Independent Commission for the Judiciary:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Judiciary (Salaries) Order, 2021.
2. The rates of salary specified in subsection (1) of section 4 of the Act in relation to the offices specified in that subsection are hereby increased as specified in the Schedule, and section 4(1) of the Act is accordingly amended.
