**THE LAW REFORM (ZONES OF SPECIAL OPERATIONS) (SPECIAL SECURITY AND  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT MEASURES) ACT**

THE LAW REFORM (ZONES OF SPECIAL OPERATIONS) (SPECIAL SECURITY AND COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT MEASURES) (NORWOOD COMMUNITY IN THE PARISH OF SAINT JAMES ZONE)  
ORDER, 2021

WHEREAS section 4 of the Law Reform (Zones of Special Operations) (Special Security and Community Development Measures) Act, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as the Act), provides that the Prime Minister in Council may, by order, declare any geographically defined area within a single continuous boundary in Jamaica, as a zone of special operations for a period not exceeding sixty days if there are reasonable grounds to believe that due to rampant criminality, gang warfare, escalating violence and murder and the threat to the rule of law and public order, it is necessary so to do:

AND WHEREAS section 4(6) of the Act provides that the Prime Minister in Council may only declare an area as a Zone if the Commissioner of Police and Chief of Defence Staff have agreed in writing that the area should be so declared:

AND WHEREAS the Commissioner of Police and Chief of Defence Staff have agreed in writing that the area geographically defined in the Schedule should be declared as a Zone:

NOW THEREFORE, the Prime Minister in Council, having reasonable cause to believe that due to rampant criminality, gang warfare, escalating violence and murder and the threat to the rule of law and public order, it is necessary to declare the area geographically defined in the Schedule as a Zone, hereby declares as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Law Reform (Zones of Special Operations) (Special Security and Community Development Measures) (Norwood Community in the parish of Saint James Zone) Order, 2021.
2. The area having the geographical limits specified in the Schedule is a zone of special operations for the purposes of the Act.
3. The said zone shall operate for a period of sixty days.

SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2)

*Area of the Zone*

- North: Beginning at the intersection of Norwood Highway and Norwood Boulevard the boundary extends in an easterly direction along Norwood Highway to the intersection with Morning Glory Crescent.
- East: The boundary then extends southerly along Morning Glory Crescent and then onto Pimento Drive to the intersection with Fifth Avenue; then southerly along an imaginary line for approximately 0.7 km (within the vicinity of a water feature).
- South: Continuing from the point in the vicinity of the water feature, the boundary extends westerly for approximately 0.5 km to the One Way Tabernacle Early Childhood Institution; then northerly for approximately 0.03 km onto Robert Reid Drive, then continuing north along Charles Drive for approximately 0.3 km; then continuing in a north-westerly direction along unnamed road for approximately 0.4 km to the Hendon/Norwood Main Road; the boundary then continues westerly along the roadway for approximately 0.2 km.
- West: The boundary then extends in a northerly direction along the Hendon/Norwood Main Road then onto the Norwood Main Road (Top Road) and continuing north onto the Norwood Highway to the starting point at the intersection of Norwood Highway and Norwood Boulevard.
