THE IRRIGATION ACT

THE MID-CLARENDON (IRRIGATION AREA) ORDER, 2022

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 3(1) of the Irrigation Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Mid-Clarendon (Irrigation Area) Order, 2022.
2. The area described in Part A of the Schedule and delineated on the map set out in Part B of the Schedule is declared to be an irrigation area for the purposes of the Act.

SCHEDULE (Paragraph 2)

PART A—*Description of Mid-Clarendon Irrigation Area*

Starting at the 35th Mile Post on the main road leading from Clarendon Park to Porus and proceeding generally southerly and easterly along the foot of the Mocho Mountains to a point of the parochial road leading from Jack Monday to Teak Pen, (this point being 1.25 miles north of the centre of the Intersection at Jack Monday of the main road leading from May Pen to Four Paths and the parochial road leading to Teak Pen); thence south-easterly along the said main road; crosses the May Pen to Four Paths main road and continuing along the railroad, towards the Rio Minho River bridge on the Sir Alexander Bustamante Highway. Thence, along the centre toll road to a point on the St. Dorothy Irrigation District boundary; and continues southerly along the said district boundary towards the coast. Thence southerly along the coast to Round Hill just west of Milk River Bay. Thence northerly along the foot of Round Hill and the Victoria Town and Little Mountain to a point due west of the starting place; thence due east in a straight line back to the starting place.
