THE NATIONAL HONOURS AND AWARDS ACT

THE NATIONAL HONOURS AND AWARDS (MEDAL OF HONOUR)
(JAMAICA DEFENCE FORCE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2019

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Governor-General by section 7 of the National Honours and Awards Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Honours and Awards (Medal of Honour) (Jamaica Defence Force) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019, and shall be read and construed as one with the National Honours and Awards (Medal of Honour) (Jamaica Defence Force) Regulations, 1970 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) and all amendments thereto.

2. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) by deleting paragraph (1) and substituting therefor the following as paragraph (1)—

“ (1) The Medal of Honour for Long Service and Good Conduct may be awarded to—

- (a) officers;
- (b) warrant officers;
- (c) non-commissioned officers; or
- (d) soldiers,

of the Regular Force who have completed eighteen years continuous service in such Force.”; and

- (b) by inserting next after paragraph (2) the following—

“ (3) For the purposes of determining the period of continuous service referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2), breaks in service not exceeding six calendar months on any occasion shall not be regarded as breaking the continuity of such service.”.
