THE NATIONAL HOUSING TRUST ACT

**THE NATIONAL HOUSING TRUST (HOUSING BENEFITS) (SPECIAL SELECTION)
(ESTUARY HOUSING DEVELOPMENT) ORDER, 2017**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by sections 20(2) and 39 of the National Housing Trust Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the National Housing Trust (Housing Benefits) (Special Selection) (Estuary Housing Development) Order, 2017, and shall be deemed to come into operation on the 20th day of December, 2016.

(2) The provisions of the National Housing Trust (Housing Benefits) Order, 1979, shall apply subject to the provisions of this Order.

2. In this Order—

“Estuary Housing Development” means the Estuary Housing Development situated at Friendship, in the parish of Saint James;

“qualified person” means a person—

- (a) who falls within any of the categories of persons specified in the first column of the Schedule;
- (b) who satisfies the eligibility requirements for a non-homeowner’s loan from the Trust to assist in the purchase of a housing solution;

Schedule.

- (c) who processes his loan to purchase a housing solution directly through the Trust;
- (d) who satisfies the Trust that he is able to make payments to repay the loan to purchase a housing solution, individually or together with a co-applicant for the loan;
- (f) who otherwise qualifies under the Act for a benefit under the non-homeowners' acquisition scheme; and
- (g) whose place of residence or employment is, in the first preference, in the parish of Saint James, and thereafter, in the parishes of Trelawny, Westmoreland and Hanover;

"special programme" means the programme described in paragraph 3;

"young adult" means a person who is between the ages of 25 and 40 years, inclusive.

3. While this Order continues in force, the Trust shall establish and operate a special programme to provide one hundred and seventy housing solutions in the Estuary Housing Development, to qualified persons.

4. In selecting qualified persons for the allocation of housing benefits under the special programme, the Trust shall accord to each category of persons specified in the first column of the Schedule, preference as respectively set out in relation to them in the second column of the Schedule.

Schedule.

5. This Order shall expire on the 31st day of December 2020, unless revoked prior to that date.

(a) young adults who have contributed to the Trust for at least five years;	(a) fifty units
(b) contributors whose income falls within the 0% band comprising weekly income of \$6,200.00 to \$12,000.99 or the 2% band comprising weekly income of \$12,000.00 to \$20,000.99 and who have contributed to the Trust for at least fifty-two weeks;	(b) fifty units
(c) members of the Jamaica Teachers Association who have contributed to the Trust for at least fifty-two weeks;	(c) fifteen units
(d) members of the Jamaica Constabulary Force who have contributed to the Trust for at least fifty-two weeks;	(d) ten units
(e) members of the Nurses Association of Jamaica who have contributed to the Trust for at least fifty-two weeks;	(e) ten units
(f) members of the Jamaica Defence Force who have contributed to the Trust for at least fifty-two weeks;	(f) ten units
(g) members of the Jamaica Civil Service Association who have contributed to the Trust for at least fifty-two weeks;	(g) fifteen units

Categories of Persons	Preference in Allocation of Housing Benefits
(h) members of trade unions which are members of the Jamaica Confederation of Trade Unions who are not public sector workers and have contributed to the Trust for at least fifty-two weeks.	(h) ten units

(BERKSHIRE COURTS OF ELTHAM) ORDER, 2018**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by sections 20(2) and 39 of the National Housing Trust Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the National Housing Trust (Housing Benefits) (Special Selection) (Berkshire Courts of Eltham) Order, 2018, and shall be deemed to come into operation on the 9th day of July, 2017.

(2) The provisions of the National Housing Trust (Housing Benefits) Order, 1979, shall apply subject to the provisions of this Order.

2. In this Order—

“Berkshire Courts of Eltham” means the Berkshire Courts of Eltham situated approximately two kilometres northwest of the Spanish Town, Town Centre, in the parish of Saint Catherine;

“qualified person” means a person—

Schedule.

- (a) who falls within any of the categories of persons specified in the first column of the Schedule;
- (b) who satisfies the eligibility requirements for a non-homeowner's loan from the Trust to assist in the purchase of a housing solution;
- (c) who processes his loan to purchase a housing solution directly through the Trust;
- (d) who satisfies the Trust that he is able to make payments to repay the loan to purchase a housing solution, individually or together with a co-applicant for the loan;
- (f) who otherwise qualifies under the Act for a benefit under the non-homeowners' acquisition scheme;
- (g) whose place of residence or employment is in the parish of Saint Catherine or Kingston and Saint Andrew; and
- (h) who has contributed to the Trust for at least fifty-two weeks;

“special programme” means the programme described in paragraph 3;

3. While this Order continues in force, the Trust shall establish and operate a special programme to provide five housing solutions in the Berkshire Courts of Eltham, to qualified persons.

Schedule.

4. In selecting qualified persons for the allocation of housing benefits under the special programme, the Trust shall accord to each category of persons specified in the first column of the Schedule, preference as respectively set out in relation to them in the second column of the Schedule.

5. This Order shall expire on the 30th day of June, 2018, unless revoked prior to that date.
