DUFFUS, P.,

The Court refuses leave to argue what purports to be a supplementary ground which was filed in the Registry on the 6th of June, 1965. The supplementary ground in itself does not conform with the Rules, in that, insufficient particulars of the misdirection complained of have not been set out, and the notice of the supplementary ground also is insufficient, in that, it does not show therein that non-compliance in the first instance was not wilful, and further it is not alleged nor shown in any way that in the interest of justice, non-compliance with the Rules should be waived, and finally the members of this Court have read the papers through and see no merit in the application. Leave to appeal is refused.
