THE REGISTRATION OF TITLES, CADASTRAL MAPPING AND TENURE CLARIFICATION (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) ACT, TEMPLE HALL II, St. ANDREW PROJECT AREA ORDER, 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Registration of Titles, Cadastral Mapping and Tenure Clarification (Special Provisions) Act, the following Order is hereby made:—

- 1. This Order shall be cited as the Registration of Titles, Cadastral Mapping and Tenure Clarification (Special Provisions) (Temple Hall II, St. Andrew Project Area) Order, 2019.
- 2. The area set out Part I of the Schedule, which is delineated on the map set out in Part II of the Schedule, is hereby declared to be a project area for the purposes of section 3 of the Act and shall be known as Temple Hall II Project Area.


PART I

TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION

Remainder of Temple Hall II, St. Andrew Project Area Registered at Volume 555 Folio 31 For Declaration by the Honourable Minister

Temple Hall II (remainder), part of Temple Hall situate at Stony Hill in the parish of Saint Andrew, consists of 31.1037 Hectares (76 acres 3 roods and 17.4 perches) of land of the shape and dimensions and building as appears on the plan annexed to the Certificate of Title registered at Volume 555 Folio 31 in the Register Book, and pre-checked survey diagram bearing examination number PE:98791. Commencing at 'A', where a spring intersects the eastern boundary of the Stony Hill to Castleton Main Road, at a bridge; thence north-westerly along this road boundary to intersect with the southern boundary of land registered at Volume 1027 Folio 188; thence north-westerly along this boundary, and continuing along the boundary between Temple Hall II and Volume 1488 Folio 403, to intersect with the boundary of land belonging to Joseph Zaidie, at Mountain Spring; thence south-easterly along the boundary between Temple Hall II and said land to intersect with the western boundary of the Parochial Road leading from Halls Green to Mount Friendship; thence south-easterly along this road boundary to intersect with the western boundary of land belonging to Lester Perkins, at Fellowship Hall; thence generally south-easterly along the boundary between Temple Hall II and Fellowship Hall, continuing along the western boundary of land belonging to David Hamilton, to the intersection of the north-eastern most corner of Temple Hall II and the north-eastern corner of lands registered at Volume 1287 Folio 993, at an old mango tree; thence south-westerly along the boundary between Temple Hall II and 1287/993 to an old concrete monument at the south-eastern corner of Volume 949 Folio 59 (land belonging to Clarice Yap Sue); thence north-westerly along the boundary between Temple Hall II and this land, crossing a spring, to the north-eastern corner of said land; thence south-westerly along the boundary between Temple Hall II and the aforesaid land to intersect with the eastern boundary of the Stony Hill to Castleton Main Road; thence general north-westerly along this road boundary back to the starting point 'A'.
