**THE STAMP DUTY ACT**

THE STAMP DUTY (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) ORDER, 2021, RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, by virtue of section 4(1) of the Stamp Duty Act (hereinafter referred to as the Act), the Minister responsible for finance may, by order, revoke, increase, reduce or alter any duty specified in the Schedule and may add any duty thereto;

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of section 4(3) of the Act, an order amending the Schedule to the Act is subject to affirmative resolution of the House of Representatives;

#### THE STAMP DUTY ACT

##### THE STAMP DUTY (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) ORDER, 2021

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister by section 4 of the Stamp Duty Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp Duty (Amendment of Schedule) Order, 2021, and shall be read and construed as one with the Stamp Duty Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments thereto.
2. The Schedule to the principal Act is amended by deleting the entry “On customs warrants inwards, per set -” and the figures “\$5.00” relating thereto, appearing under the heading “CUSTOMS WARRANTS - ADHESIVE STAMPS MAY BE USED”.
