THE TAX COLLECTION ACT

THE TAX COLLECTION (APPROVED WRITE-OFF) (No. 4) ORDER, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister by section 47A(4) of the *Tax Collection Act* (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Tax Collection (Approved Write-Off) (No. 4) Order, 2020.
2. Subject to section 47A (5) of the Act, I, as Minister, declare that—
 - (a) there is uncollected the sum of \$1,397,142,722.58 in tax arrears in respect of taxpayers other than public bodies,
 - (b) the sum specified in paragraph (a) is a total sum comprised of individual sums shown in the attached Schedule for each Revenue Service Centre or Tax Office listed in the Schedule;

- (c) the Commissioner General has determined that the sum specified in sub-paragraph (a), is uncollectible; and
- (d) the sum specified in sub-paragraph (a), as it relates to the taxpayers other than public bodies, is written-off.
