THE TAX COLLECTION ACT

THE TAX COLLECTION (APPROVED WRITE-OFF) (No. 6) ORDER, 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister by section 47A(4) of the Tax Collection Act (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Tax Collection (Approved Write-Off) (No. 6) Order, 2019.
 - 2. Subject to section 47A (5) of the Act, I, as Minister, declare that—
 - (a) there is uncollected the sum of \$388,669,789.85 in tax arrears in respect of taxpayers other than public bodies;
 - (b) the sum specified in paragraph (a) is a total sum comprised of individual sums shown in the attached Schedule for each Revenue Service Centre or Tax Office and the Revenue Appeals Division listed in the Schedule;
 - (c) the Commissioner General has determined that the sum specified in sub-paragraph (a), is uncollectible; and

(d)	the sum specified in sub-paragraph (a), as it relates to the taxpayers other th	an
	public bodies, is written-off.
