THE TAX COLLECTION ACT

THE TAX COLLECTION (APPROVED WRITE-OFF) (PUBLIC BODIES) (No. 3) ORDER, 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister by section 47A(4) of the *Tax Collection Act* (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Tax Collection (Approved Write-Off) (Public Bodies) (No. 3) Order, 2019.
 - 2. Subject to section 47A(5) of the Act, I, as Minister, declare that-
 - (a) there is uncollected the sum of \$2,641,485,950.76 in tax arrears in respect of public bodies;
 - (b) the sum specified in paragraph (a) is a total comprised of individual sums shown in the attached Schedule for the Revenue Service Centres listed in the Schedule;
 - (c) the Commissioner General has determined that the sum specified in sub-paragraph (a), is uncollectible; and

(d)) the sum specified in subparagraph (a), as it relates to the tax arrears of pul	
	bodies listed in the attached Schedule, is written-off.
