THE TAX COLLECTION ACT

**THE TAX COLLECTION (APPROVED WRITE-OFF) (PUBLIC BODIES)
ORDER, 2020**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister by section 47A(4) of the Tax Collection Act (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Tax Collection (Approved Write-Off) (Public Bodies) Order, 2020.
2. Subject to section 47A (5) of the Act, I, as Minister, declare that—
 - (a) there is uncollected the sum of \$94,166,474.59 in tax arrears in respect of public bodies;
 - (b) the sum specified in paragraph (a) is a total comprised of individual sums shown in the attached Schedule for the Revenue Service Centres listed in the Schedule;
 - (c) the Commissioner General has determined that the sum specified in sub-paragraph

- (a), is uncollectible; and
- (d) the sum specified in subparagraph (a), as it relates to the tax arrears of public bodies listed in the attached Schedule, is written-off.
