THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT

THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS (REGULATORY FEES) REGULATIONS,
2021–2022

In exercise of the power conferred on the Office pursuant to section 16 of the Telecommunications Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Telecommunications (Regulatory Fees) Regulations, 2021/2022.
2. Each holder of a telecommunications carrier licence and service provider licence shall pay the appropriate regulatory fees to the Office as specified in the paragraphs below.

SCHEDULE OF REGULATORY FEES EFFECTIVE 1ST APRIL, 2021

3. Generally, the computation of the regulatory fee applicable to a licensee in the telecommunications sector is calculated on the basis of the following formula (and shall be payable upon presentation of invoice by the Office):

$$RF_A = RA/R_T * TB$$

where RF_A = Annual Regulatory fee for company "A"
 R_A = Applicable revenues for company "A"
 R_T = Total applicable revenues of all relevant companies
 TB = Total applicable budget for telecommunications activities

For the financial year beginning 1st April, 2021 the following values apply:—

R_T = 79,666,411,111
 TB = 385,529,334

4. Notwithstanding the formula in paragraph 3 above, there shall be minimum regulatory fees as follows:

<i>Licensees</i>	<i>Regulatory Fees</i> (J\$)
Carrier	300,000.00
Service Provider	50,000.00

5. Subject to paragraph 6 below, where the information regarding applicable revenues for computing regulatory fees according to the formula in paragraph 3 above is not available to the Office, or if the calculated regulatory fees using the formula is lower than the applicable minimum regulatory fees specified in paragraph 4 above, then the licensee shall pay the applicable minimum regulatory fee (and such fee shall be payable upon presentation of invoice by the Office).

6. Where the minimum regulatory fee is charged because the information regarding applicable revenues for computing regulatory fees is not available to the Office, this will be a temporary arrangement pending receipt of this information. Once the information is received by the Office, the appropriate regulatory fee that should have been payable effective April 1st 2021, using the formula set out in paragraph 3 above, will be calculated. The difference between the minimum regulatory fee invoiced and the regulatory fee now calculated, if any, shall be payable by the licensee (and such amount shall be payable upon presentation of invoice by the Office).

ELECTRICITY (REGULATORY SERVICE FEES) REGULATIONS,
2021/2022

In exercise of the power conferred on the Office pursuant to section 4(5) of the Office of Utilities Regulation Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electricity (Regulatory Service Fees) Regulations, 2021/2022.
2. Each holder of an electricity supply or generation licence shall pay the appropriate regulatory fees to the Office as prescribed by the formula set out in its respective licence or as listed in the following Schedule:—

THE OFFICE OF UTILITIES REGULATION ACT
WATER AND SEWERAGE (REGULATORY SERVICE FEES)
REGULATIONS, 2021/2022

In exercise of the power conferred on the Office pursuant to section 4(5) of the Office of Utilities Regulation Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water and Sewerage (Regulatory Service Fees) Regulations, 2021/2022.

2. Each holder of a water supply licence and/or sewerage service provider licence shall pay appropriate regulatory fees to the Office as prescribed by the formula set out in its respective licence where applicable or as listed in the following Schedule:

National Water Commission	204,488,160
Other Small Water and/or Sewerage Providers	As specified in the respective licences or the minimum of \$125,000.00
