

THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT

A PROCLAMATION



PATRICK L. ALLEN,

By His Excellency, the Most Honourable Sir
PATRICK LINTON ALLEN, Member of the Order
of the Nation, Knight Grand Cross of the Most
Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint
George, Commander of the Order of Distinction,
Knight of Grace of the Most Venerable Order
of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem,
Governor-General of Jamaica.

WHEREAS the seat occupied by Rudyard Spencer, formerly a member of the House of Representatives for the constituency of Clarendon South Eastern, became vacant with effect from the 3rd day of February 2020:

AND WHEREAS it has become necessary to hold an election in the said constituency to fill that vacancy in the membership of the House of Representatives:

AND WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of Section 19 of the Representation of the People Act that the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint the day upon which the poll shall be held at any election:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK LINTON ALLEN, Member of the Order of the Nation, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Order of Distinction, Knight of Grace of the Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem, Governor-General of Jamaica, DO HEREBY APPOINT the 2nd day of March 2020, as the day on which the poll shall be held at the said election.

Given under my hand and the Broad Seal of Jamaica at King's House, this 6th day of February in the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand and Twenty and the Sixty-ninth Year of the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
