THE TOLL ROADS (REGISTERS) REGULATIONS, RESOLUTION, 2018

WHEREAS, by virtue of section 32(1) of the Toll Roads Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Authority may, with the approval of the Minister, make regulations for giving effect to the provisions and purposes of this Act;

AND WHEREAS by virtue of section 32(2) of the Act, the Regulations made under subsection (1) shall be subject to affirmative resolution;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the Toll Roads (Registers) Regulations, 2018 be affirmed:

- (i) This Resolution may be cited as the Toll Roads (Registers) Regulations, Resolution, 2018;
- (ii) The Toll Roads (Registers) Regulations, 2018, which were laid on the Table of the House on the 20th day of March, 2018, are hereby affirmed.

THE TOLL ROADS ACT

THE TOLL ROADS (REGISTERS) REGULATIONS, 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Authority by section 32 of the Toll Roads Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made, with the approval of the Minister:—

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Toll Roads (Register) Regulations, 2018.

Authority shall keep Registers. Schedule.

- 2. The Authority shall keep the following registers in the respective forms specified in the Schedule hereto, for—
 - (a) annual toll road usuage, in the form set out as Form 1;
 - (b) incidents, in the form set out as Form 2;
 - (c) annual collision statistics, in the form set out as Form 3;
 - (d) complaints, in the form set out as Form 4;

Quality management system and audit report.

- 3. The concessionaire shall have a quality management system which shall be subject to internal audits at planned intervals to determine whether—
 - (a) the activities conform with the requirements of the quality management system; and
 - (b) the quality management system is effectively implemented and maintained.

Operational and maintenance procedures.

4. The concessionaire shall submit to the Authority, current and updated copies of operational and maintenance procedures under the quality management system.
